

# HEAVEN

Greetings World!!!

I'm honored that you would welcome me on this very important and powerful subject of the (CG) Afterlife Guarantee: A Perfect Future. I would like to present the Perfect Future to you. I would like to provide the Guarantee for you and I ask that you give me a hearing that will probe deep into your heart and into your soul in terms of your choices concerning the Future.

At this very moment of this recording. 33 miners in the beautiful land of Chile are caught underneath the earth. They have been there about two and a half months, knowing that rescue is on the way. For you see, when the mine-shaft collapsed, they could not get out and for two weeks they were completely lost to the world. Their families did not know that they were alive, when on the fifteenth day they were able to get a message out saying, 'We are alive. All of us are well.' Immediately the whole country mobilized. They were exhilarated with the possibilities of rescuing these people. They found the finest mining experts in order to bring rescue to these 33. They said it would take about four months before a rescue shaft was built. They

provided several plans and finally in the next few hours as I address you, we are hoping that all 33 will be brought out. In the meanwhile for the last few months, there's been a hole that has been the communication between those trapped under the mine, as well as those above ground. They've sent water. They've sent food. They've also let down cameras, tiny cameras where the miners, for the sake of their families, would come close to the camera, press their faces against the camera to show their families that they were alive. Commentators say that these miners were filled with hope and happiness even as people above the ground were filled with joy and anticipation and expectation. Now, these miners, for about two and a half months, they have been in a small place; 380 some square feet. They are 33 of them. They have to live in it. They have had to work in it. They have to eat with the food that has been supplied to them uh and, with others. Uh, they are about half a mile under the ground, about 2,300 feet. This has been a very trying time for them but the very fact that there's a possibility of rescue keeps their hopes alive and even provides them a bit of happiness in the middle of their imperfect present situation.

You and I are like those miners. We are in an imperfect present situation.

Notice your imperfect present could be relational. You have been betrayed

by those whom you loved and those whom you love have sensed your betrayal. Uh, the desires and hopes for the relationship that would blossom into beautiful uh young and old love have been broken. Relational. There's also economic imperfection. During this time of the global crises people have been knocking on doors hoping for employment. If you lose your job that you don't like, a hundred people are ready to take your job. Your boss hates you and you hate your employees. Or if you are the owner of the business you are wondering about how the cash flow situation can be handled because banks are unwilling to lend to you as they look at your bottom line and the prospects do not seem good. Others of you are in a uh mental imperfect present. You are full of anxiety and worry. You look at the future and you're at the edge of your intellectual resources. You do not know what tomorrow is going to bring. It's an imperfect present. And then there is physical imperfection, isn't it? All of us have borne pain. Some of us have borne greater pain. Of course there is no pain, no more pain than what one person can experience, and yet people have experienced the greatest pain. This last year our world has been filled with tragedies of epic proportion. It started with the earthquake in Haiti which completely devastated the capital city of Port-au-Prince. I had the privilege of being there with those who are weeping. 230,000 people killed. Another 300,000

missing; meaning they are in the pancaked buildings all over their city. Uh, the floods in Pakistan. Uh, millions of people unsettled. About twenty million people. All over the world. Physical, imperfect present. There's also another imperfect present. It's called the spiritual imperfect present isn't it? Where you are sensing the load of your own guilt. Uh where you don't have forgiveness. You're sensing estrangement and alienation before God. You know that you have not met God's expectations of you; that's another imperfect present. So, all of us have at some degree or some way having to cope with the imperfections of the present. Somebody said there are layers of imperfection: irritation, frustration and aggravation. An assistant of mine said uh, 'if a person calls me on my desk phone and introduces himself as George, asking for Ramesh Richard every hour on the hour, I get irritated with him. If he calls me on my hand phone after office hours in the night and says, 'this is George, I want to talk to Ramesh Richard,' I get frustrated with him. But if he calls me at 2 a.m. in the morning, drunk and says, 'this is Ramesh Richard, I want to see if there are any messages for me', I really get aggravated with George. All of us have some degree of imperfection in our present don't we? Actually, our daughter's basketball coach used to coin a word, I don't know that he knew the difference, but he put 'frustration' and

‘flustered’ together and called it ‘flustration’. And that’s how the present feels – FLUSTRATED. The imperfect present.

Is there a way to go from the Imperfect Present to a Perfect Future? And can that way be guaranteed?

## Part 2

Let me ask you. Would you like a chance to start up life again? Would you love a second chance at life? Uh, would, uh, you want to overcome the sense of regret that fills your soul? Do you wish you had time? Time to get things done that need to get done. Time to explore everything there is. Time to even take time. Do you wish you could go back to places that you visited that you so enjoyed but you don’t have the resources to do that, especially in terms of time? Do you wish you could go places that you’ve heard of or read about? And uh, you’re unable to do this? Do you wish you could be released from all the limitations that you feel and you face inside your system? Do you wish you could have a guarantee of this life that is secure and an eternity that’s ensured? Are you simply going to live by wish and wish? That’s actually a pointer. It’s a pointer that you are not really made for where you presently find yourself. It’s a pointer that you are really made for the

Afterlife. That's kind of my focus in this talk. The title of this talk is, "The Afterlife Guarantee: Perfect Future". So I want to talk first about the (CG) Afterlife; then about the (CG)Perfect Future and then we'll talk about the (CG) Guarantee.

The people try to consult all sorts of sources and resources for the Afterlife. They look for psychic help and astrological help and mediums as well as holotropic insight and revelation and near-death experiences and so on. But it's not very complicated.

One thing we are all agreed is that there is going to be death. We can sugar-coat it, we can tamper with it, we can try to dampen it. I have tried to philosophically and intellectually somehow destroy death but death gets the better of me and I am going to be victimized by it. Medical technology is on the verge of uh elongating life. Maybe to 150 or 200 years. And uh we may be able to delay death but you're not going to overcome it. With some expectation and hope people try to get their heads in to cryonic situations, freezing them, paying a lot of money, and perhaps in the future being resuscitated. But death is going to get the better of us. Uh, it equalizes rich and poor, it dampens our enthusiasm for life itself. We're like miners, under the earth.

There was a lady who tried to lengthen her life and delay death was a Mrs. Beijing Lee who called her doctor after a massive heart attack and said, ‘doctor, in about a year my grandson is going to be graduating from high school. Can you keep me alive for one year?’ And the doctor said, “We’ll try”. When the grandson graduated Mrs. Beijing Lee called the doctor and said, uh, ‘you know me. I would like to see if you could keep me alive for another two years to be there for my granddaughter’s wedding. Would you be able to do that for me doc?’ And the doctor said, ‘we’ll do our best.’ He prescribed some medicines, gave her some rigorous regimen and Mrs. Beijing Lee followed it to the detail. And finally Mrs. Beijing Lee she celebrated her 80<sup>th</sup> birthday. And she called the doctor and says, ‘you might remember me doctor. I was the one you gave me an extra year to go to my grandson’s graduation. You gave me another 2 years to go to my granddaughter’s wedding; well, I have just bought a Certificate of Deposit with a long term maturity date of about 20 years.’ People try to delay their death but death is going to be sure. Somebody said, ‘everybody wants to go to Heaven but nobody wants to die. So we look at options when it comes to the afterlife. There are not really that many options. I’ve treated this subject on our website and I can get you that information. Just go to our website. I would love to hear from you. I have done a talk on Killing Death; how to kill

death itself. Another talk on, Life After Death: Options and Offers. I actually, more recently, I have done a talk on the problem of Hell. Or how you can reverse your destination. You know you don't have to do anything to get to hell. You just go on the way you are. But if you receive Someone Who can give you the rescue from Hell, He can take you to the other place. There are not really many options in terms of the afterlife. Either you're going no where, but if you go no where, that's not the Perfect Future because you don't know that it's the Perfect Future. Or you come back here. Somewhere the constiuence of the scale of reality up or down but you're never sure and that won't be a Perfect Future; at least not now able to think about a Perfect Future that you can be guaranteed. Or, you go somewhere; Heaven or Hell. Those are the options aren't they?

### Part 3

I'm speaking about the other side of Hell. You take whatever is true and good and beautiful on this earth and you take it into the level of the ideal and you'll find the smelling, the sounding, the sensing of heaven in your heart. It's amazing. Wherever you go in this world, regardless of culture and geographies and religion and philosophies, there is heaven almost written inside the human soul. And that's why every one of these ideologies, regardless of where they are from, across the world, has a concept of heaven.

Now they have varied views but it's essentially the same. Meaning, uh there's something in the human heart which longs for a future that is different from the imperfections of the present that will be beautiful, true and good in this ideal form. Perhaps you are hard-wired for eternity. Perhaps you have a heaven-bent heart. Maybe it's written in your heart. That's why, even people sing to you and say, 'Imagine there's no heaven'. It's much harder to imagine there's no heaven than to imagine there is a heaven. You've got to be singing, 'imagine there is no heaven' while you are internally convinced that there has to be a heaven to address all the imperfect; to address all the imperfect matters of the present. Now, you can wait 'til after you die to make decisions about the future but it'll be too late. You may have heard of the man who uh told his doctor that uh he got three second opinions and all of the other three doctors disagreed with his diagnosis and the doctor calmly replied, 'after we get your autopsy you can decide and you will know that I'm right.' Uh, now that will be too late. The Afterlife is a scenario for playing out the Perfect Future. So let's talk about The Perfect Future.

The Perfect Future is difficult for me to explain because I've not experienced it. I'm a novice at it. And the eye has not seen nor ear heard the things that are still there unless in some way if it was shown to me, it'll be

difficult for me to explain it. It'll be somewhat like my attempts to tell you what uh are the masterpieces of the Louvre in Paris, France. If I were to say, 'I saw this beautiful woman whose called the Mona Lisa', lovely lady with a fine face and a smirk of a smile. It seems like she's hiding something behind her. We don't know what the ambiguity is that the artist was attempting to present. You will smile at my smile about her smile, because you are much more of an art expert. You're an art historian. You're an art specialist. Or next door when I saw the aphrodite, or the Aphrodite, the Venus of Milos. If I were to say it's a woman with broken arms, you would say, 'wait a second. You don't know enough art. That's one of the most sensual, most beautiful pieces there is on the planet'; and that's how it's going to be with heaven. I can kind of , at my level, tell you that I recognized a good thing, but you, because of your deep awareness and experience, you know much deeper, better, greater stuff. That's how I'm going to explain heaven to you.

First of all in sort of a (CG) revised version of the earth, because we have to use present categories at the level of the experience and secondly, (CG) in a new edition of reality itself. So, first, heaven as a revised edition of the earth. All we've got to do is use superlatives; because we are comparing things that

we know at the present to try to show you how great and how wonderful and how consummate and beautiful and marvelous the superlative extrapolation technique. I can say, 'it's first class,' 'it's world class', 'it's premier', but I'm still using earthly portraits to show you what heaven is like in its revised version of the earth.

Let me give you four portraits of a revised version of the earth and you'll understand some of the meaning of those metaphors.

(CG) Heaven would be like a banquet – number one. A banquet. A party. A festival. A carnival. You've been to those banquets, uh, where there's scrumptious food and plentiful celebrations, wonderful drinks. Hoping that you don't think about the debauched side of the party, remember, heaven is the true, good, and beautiful side of the earth. You'll be the celebrity of the banquet and if anybody questions why you should be there at the banquet, you can say, 'the owner has invited me'; and here is the invitation card. This is a promise from him and even the bouncer at the front gate will let you in because you know the owner.

#### Part 4

A second portrait of heaven is that of a garden. (CG) Heaven will be like a garden. A garden. What image does a garden conjure inside your mind. Now, for my wife it conjures all sorts of pleasantness and beauty. You've

been to nature spots all over the world and as I have, I can't forget the Rain Forest of beautiful Costa Rica or the sea fronds of Fiji in the South Pacific or the mountains of Nepal. Only if it's over 20,000 feet did they call it a mountain. Everywhere else those are just hills; they would call them. I am told that a tourist in Nepal said she could not see the scenery because the mountains kept getting in her way. Uh nature spots. Those beautiful spots of the world. Gardens. In the morning sometimes my wife and I take a little walk beside of our house where she's planted flowers. And for me a flower is a flower. Maybe it's a red flower and a blue flower and a yellow flower but for her, she knows the names and the specimens and the species of these flowers. Particular kinds. For me a bird is a bird but she knows what kind of birds they are. Garden, lush, healthy, growing, cultivated and wild, extravagant and beautiful. That's a portrait of heaven. Just imagine a garden. A world wide garden. Another portrait; not only a banquet and a garden, (CG) Heaven is like a city. I'm going to call it a city. That seems like the opposite of a garden but a city has a life of it's own; pulsating life, especially during Happy Hour as it were or unfortunately peak hour traffic. Now contemporary urbanologists and architects are trying to plan the city of the future which will be most human, which will be fully plugged in; where there will be no problems with sanitation and health problems and there'll be

ample water, potable drinking water and renewable energy. The Architect of the Heavenly City. He's been at it from Eternity. He created this earth and if this earth is beautiful and it's cities, whether it's a super hotel, cities which mark the skyline of the finest cities of the world, 7-Star, 8-Star, 10- Star; this heaven is going to be a city. Not only a banquet and a garden and a city, a fourth portrait of heaven is (CG) Heaven will be home. going to be HOME. Home at last. I travel as you travel and after awhile travel gets rather tiring doesn't it? We don't like the inside of hotel rooms and airplane cabins. We're waiting to get home. Especially if you have a happy home because you have a fabulous family there. You have the familiarity of your own room, of your bed. You can even find the washroom in the dark. You know you belong and there is happiness there. The Perfect Future – Heaven in a revised version of the earth, will feel just like home. You say, 'my goodness, how come I waited this long to get there'. So that's the use of superlatives. Heaven is another kind of earth. Uh, perhaps the best known contemporary theoretical physicist uh has now come up with the grand design book where he's talking about how all reality depends on the observer. He's calling it, "Theory Dependent Realism". Now, that particular Theory Dependent Realism has no objective, empirical uh support for it. It's philosophical at the theological constructive. It's not something that you observe and you

come to it. I like his analogy however in terms of heaven and earth.

Sometimes called apposite. Not opposite but apposite analogies, that they are suitable and relevant to one another and these two writers have talked about how a gold fish attempts to construct the walls outside the spherical goldfish bowl and say those are all curved walls. Now what the theory says is that both the goldfish and humans, even though humans know that the walls are rectilinear know that they can experience their realities in their own way and each would be correct; except the humans know that the goldfish's view of their rectilinear room as a curved wall is not true. It's only for the goldfish that it's true of reality but the human's view of reality includes the goldfish's view of reality. Ahh, that's the limitation of trying to talk about Heaven. Heaven includes the earth in it's best, beautiful, good and true form but earth does not include heaven. We can only be like a goldfish trying to describe through our spherical fishbowls as to what Heaven is like. But those are four beautiful portraits. Superlative. The revised edition of the plant earth.

## Part 5

The Perfect Future from the Imperfect Present has one side to it called The Revised Edition of the Earth. A superlative extrapolation but now comes the major, major difference. A disjunction, a category changing event when I try

to describe where Heaven is not like the earth. That too is the Perfect Future awaiting you and me. Heaven and Hell have nothing in common but Heaven and earth have some continuation and commonalities but heaven is also another kind of a different kind. It's not only continuation of the earth it has a uniqueness of its own. It's a new creation. It's a supernatural creation. New additional reality itself. Now, let me throw around four concepts since I gave you four portraits of how heaven is going to be so incredibly distinct of another kind; a category changing, new edition. Here are they are. First, (CG) heaven uh will be featured by constant newness. Constant newness. Here is a problem of earth. Everything constantly gets old. You get old. Your technology gets old. Your spouse gets old. Your car gets old. What if we had a dimension where everything becomes new every day; in self renewing every day? Can you imagine that? That addresses the human problem of boredom. Boredom is simply tedium with what you already have. You don't like what you do or you have to do what you don't like to do. In philosophy we call it a 'condition' but in psychology they call it an 'emotion'. You cannot latch on to any specific activity. The history of philosophy and psychoanalysis says that 'mankind's fundamental need is to seek pleasure and to avoid pain'. In fact they pursued pleasure even while going through pain. In constant newness. You will not have boredom and

tedium. What about entropy? You know our earth; everything is running down. The amount of energy available is going down and that's the second law isn't it? But in heaven everything will be constantly renewed and renewed because everything will be made new. New creation, new heavens, new earth.

The story is told of the global economic crises generating anxiety where people want security. They don't know where to put their money and if the money is safe they don't know whether it will grow and if it does grow whether it'll stay at the growth levels. They are getting into gold. Gold has broken record pricings. Actually as an instrument would not just yield investment returns on it. As an instrument, it's an end in itself. Basically for security reasons to be a hedge against future inflation and so on. I'm told of a man who finally cashed in all his reserves of hard cash and said, 'I want to buy gold, bullion. Either through exchange rate transfers or through other exchange trading promise.' Unfortunately he's just about to die. So he pleads with God. He says, 'God, can I bring something into heaven? Would you allow me just one suitcase of something into heaven? I'd like to bring a suitcase of gold.' And God said, 'Sure, you can bring a suitcase of gold into heaven'. And he gets into heaven with his gold-filled suitcase and his friends

who had preceded him in death look at him and say, ‘what are you bringing to heaven? Gold? That’s what we use for asphalt and concrete on our road ways, as pavement.’ ‘Cause it’s a different value. It’s constantly renewed. The things that we held so deeply and preciously on the earth are going to be inverted when it comes to possessions and things. Constant newness.

## Part 6

A second concept. I’m going to call that (CG) Absolute Goodness. On this earth you don’t have Absolute Goodness. You may have some relative goodness compared to others. but Absolute Goodness? For example, freedom. If there’s absolutely good, you will freely chose what you should freely chose and not be disappointed as to what you cannot freely choose. Or what about love? It would be absolutely good. Love is the ultimate good. Love is eternal. The greatest of everything is love. What about work? What about absolutely good work? Where you have purpose and meaning in every way. That would be absolutely good work.

Absolute good in terms of sex. You know one of the reasons uh people don’t want to go to heaven, they think God is against sex. Except God is the One Who created sex, you know. Uh, if you think a sexually fulfilling life is good, it is the same difference between a sexual fulfilling life and a prenatal existence when you didn’t even know you existed. Just imagine what

Heaven is going to be like in another dimension; in a hugely different, another kind of way where the sex of goodness and the goodness of sex will be completely overwhelming and rewritten. And if you think this is good, wait 'til the Creator Who has thought up sex and inside His boundaries is best, has stuff for you that you cannot even envision. Oh! What about food, you know? Absolute goodness in food? I know there are many nutritionists listening to me and not all food is good for you. I'm told that a man said, he's not going to eat any chicken or eggs because of bird flu and he's not going to eat beef because of Mad Cow Disease. He was not going to eat fish because of all the metals inside the meat and he was not going to use pork because of swine flu. He was not going to eat vegetables for sure and fruit because of insecticides and herbicides. The only thing he would eat was chocolate. Uh, however, in Heaven, it's going to be all nutritious. And you'll enjoy the banquet. Remember we said. And you will enjoy food. But goodness in the deeper ways; goodness in terms of virtue, where there's always integrity. Goodness in terms of action where there's decisive good morality and action. What about absolute goodness when it comes to motives? Pure, sincere, absolutely pure motives. Just imagine. What about goodness in terms of the environment? Where there's no global warming cooling cycles; and everybody gets very upset in terms of an eco-unfriendly

world. There'll be an eco-friendly situation. Or what about goodness in terms of nature? The highest beauty that you've ever seen. What about goodness in terms of relationships? Nobody to betray; nobody will betray you. Because all of you have already been forgiven. What about absolute goodness when it comes to corruption? There will be no corruption there. There'll be no sin there. It's all been taken care of. No more transgression. No more worries about who's going to do wrong. That's absolute goodness. Beyond all you could imagine.

Sometime ago we had a 900 square feet office space which we rented; which we used well. We created some memories and some good projects. Not knowing that just in three or four years I would be in an office that's beautiful; built out just for us. And the old office simply became a memory. A nostalgic memory and soon we would forget what that was all about. We preserved the good from the past into the present but the present was incredibly better; absolutely better than what was happening in the past. And then to top it all off, the new office space, not only big and spacious, it was also free. Free of rent, free of operating costs. How much better could it be? Heaven is going to be absolutely good. There'll be no tears, no sorrow, no

death, no pain. It's going to be absolutely good and No impurities of what so ever kind.

## Part 7

A third double descriptor, double noun. I'm going to call it (CG) 'total awareness'. Total awareness. Now you will not be omniscient because only God is omniscient but you'll be far more aware. You know, you've cleaned out your glasses or the computer screen or your windshield and you've known clarity of a kind uh that is better than your present situation. But what if you were absolutely aware of everything that is happening around you? Totally aware. Totally aware of explanations. Explanations as to why reality was the way it was. Why we had so much grief and pain and death. Why did we have the tsunamis? Why did we have the earthquakes. Why do we have killings and murders and fratricide and genocide? Why? Well, because heaven is full of light. You'll be able to see reality as it was. An explanation of reality. Because that is what life does. Light gives explanations. You're able to see things clearly like never before. You know what light is. Light is basically, in nature's way of transferring energy through space. If you have sheer light, you can go to the moon and back in just 2 ½ seconds and that'll

be explanation of reality but it'll also be explanation of experiences.

Explanation of consequences when you get to heaven. Somebody said, "your first words would be, 'Of course'." I think your first words will be 'WoW'. As you look at things in microcosm and nano scale and you look at things in huge, humongous scale. And your second words of course will be 'I see'. Now I see why all those bad things happened. There was a good purpose in it. How God turned evil into good. We'll see all the connections; all the dots. But you'll also see consequences because heaven is far more than just explanations; it'll also be justice. It'll be the rectification of all the evil in the world and justice being meted out and you will have explanations of the consequences but also the total awareness of who you are. You'll be finally human. You will know yourself. Even now you have the ability and the capacity to look at your body from outside yourself – the only creature who can do that. Right now we live in three or four dimension models and we can imagine 10 and 11 dimension models and what if you were uh unleashed from all your physical limitations and you'd think and instantly you could travel anywhere in the galaxies of all the planets? The ability to not only think but actually move in inter-galactic special travel. You will be able to be aware of others. You saw them on this earth; so limited. I have a friend who's got cerebral palsy. He's broken in body but his mind is full of

hope that if he's not healed right now, one day he'll have a body that is completely full and free of pain of the cerebral palsy; unlimited. Yesterday a friend of mine actually had his wife walk away from him. After having cheated and defrauded him and committing adultery. Uh, you know, he is not perfect; either, and both of them actually, can one day be in the perfect future. Oh we can go on with your identity. Awareness of who you are. Awareness of who others are. You have capacities as never before. You have abilities as never before. But the final awareness would be that of God Himself.

The awareness of God's presence; of God's face. Because heaven is where God is and hell is where God is not. And deep inside your heart is the need to see God. The need to be aware of God's presence. That's why you can have a little bit of heaven on earth even right now but when you get to the Perfect Future, you'll have the glorious presence and face of God.

I was in India not too long ago. And uh taxi drivers in India, they call themselves the best taxi drivers in the world because they're not afraid to die. And uh, my taxi driver, I knew he was not afraid to die and I said, 'Listen, when you die and go to heaven and God says, 'why should I let you in, what would you answer?' And my taxi driver said, 'I would say to God, I

want to see your face. I've been told of you, I've been looking for you and today I want to see your face. Would you let me into your heaven so I can see your face?' Ah, the taxi driver had a point. Because heaven will not be heaven. The Perfect Future will not be perfect unless God is there. That will be total awareness. Constant newness. Absolute goodness. You will know as you are known.

## Part 8

The fourth concept of heaven is (CG) permanent fullness. Permanent fullness. On this earth you and I are lacking a lot. We lack in every way. We not only lack social stuff. We lack spiritual stuff. We lack physical stuff. We lack in every way. This life is full of lacks. What you're missing. But heaven will be permanent fullness. It will make up all your lacks. It will compensate for all your lacks. Oh, another problem of the earth; not only our lacks but our losses. You and I have lost things. Lost people. I have a cousin of mine who went through many personal losses in terms of losing family. When he was young, he lost his younger brother, a little later, his father and then his mother. Lost family members. When became married he went through an accident or an incident. He was disfigured in face because fire blew up on his face. And then he lost his son to a car accident and he lost his daughter who took her life. And eventually he died. Having loss after loss, I don't

know anybody who has borne that kind of a pain. Actually there is no more pain than any one person can bear but he bore the worst in my experience. Is there no hope for him? Is there no explanation for it? Is there no way to make up for all his losses? Yes, there is. Because in the Perfect Future there will be fullness of joy. There will be pleasures and delights evermore in the presence of the One Who dominates heaven because in the core, joy is the emotion of heaven. Not just happiness. It's the permanent emotion of heaven and God is the central Person, the central Feature of heaven.
